CALL FOR ABSTRACTS – CLOSING DATE FRIDAY 17 SEPTEMBER 2010

A. COMMUNITY FORUM

Abstracts are invited for Oral presentations to the Community forum. The audience is composed mainly of members of the lay public as well as senior high school students.

Presentations should be of 10 minutes duration with a 5 minute question time. Presentations should highlight:

- What the project is?
- Why it is important to do this research?
- What are the implications of the research to Australia's health?

The presentations should be in lay language and able to be understood by the public.

B. SCIENTIFIC FORUM

Abstracts are invited for Oral or Poster presentations.

Instructions for all abstracts:

The abstract must be in 12 point Times New Roman font and fit on a single page with margins of 3cm on all edges. The abstract should contain:

- Title (in capitals and bold)
- Authors (with name of presenting author underlined)
- Department or Division, include email address of presenting author
- The body of the abstract should then contain Aim/s, Methods, Results, Discussion and/or Conclusion
- Abstracts will be printed in the program in their original format

The Scientific Committee will indicate if the abstracts are to be presented orally or by poster.
